MIYAJIMA

WORLD CULTURAL HERITAGE



Built above the sea of Miyajima, high tide makes this shrine more beautiful, as it looks as if it is floating on the water. The main building and the corridor of the shrine total 275 meters in length, and there is a Taka-Butai (High Stage) and a Hira-Butai (Open Stage) where traditional Bugaku (musical court dances) were held. At low tide, visitors can walk to the Otorii gate, which rests about 200 meters offshore from the shrine.

HIROSHIMA PEACE MEMORIAL PARK

This building was originally the Hiroshima Prefectural Industrial Promotion Hall. On August 6th, 1945, the world's first atomic bomb wreaked havoc on the city. As the pressure from the blast came from above, miraculously only part of this structure was destroyed. What remains of the structure has become a symbolic figure in Hiroshima City. The domed steel frame was named "A-Bomb Dome," and was designated as a World Heritage Site in 1996. People from all over the world visit this location to pray for the abolition of nuclear weapons and world peace.
